



Welcome to the 11th annual One Earth Film Festival

Whether this is your first time, or you are an old friend, it's so good to see you! Once again, we are meeting mainly virtually due to the COVID-19 pandemic. But we are also mixing in some Chicago-based in-person or virtual events so that communities can more closely experience a particular event or film, discussion or action.

All Hands On Deck

However you join us, we hope you can participate in several important discussions. This is a crucial moment. There are many emergencies converging at once: the climate crisis, environmental justice catastrophes, extinction and more.

Our film lineup reveals our present-moment crisis. In "Plastic Bag Store: The Film," the filmmakers have cleverly repackaged the waste that is choking our ecosystems and ourselves.

"Bring Your Own Brigade" is an unforgiving film about raging forest fires on the U.S. West Coast. The camera captures cars driving through mountains ablaze with fire.

At the Young Filmmakers Contest Awards event, "Creativity" award-winner Jaqki Guerrero's film "Our Generation" accuses older generations of lighting the world on fire: "We are the matches being lit like a bonfire," she says in her spoken word film.

Turn the Tide

The chaos of this moment called us to establish a powerful theme for our festival this year: Turn the tide. We need

to work together to change direction in this pressing environmental emergency. It's tempting to close your eyes, to look away...but we ask that you stay present. Our awareness and action can change what we see in the future.

After each film, expert panelists will tell their stories, deepening our understanding of the issues, and helping define effective responses. Spoiler alert: recycling is no longer an effective strategy (at least in the U.S.)

Several of our films explore amazing solutions that are achievable and affordable. "Inhabitants" reveals age-old land management practices that can

make agriculture a net positive on climate change.

The global youth climate movement is a growing voice on the world's stage – everyone knows "Greta" by her first name, and other new young leaders are emerging, such as the young women profiled in "Girls for Future."

We hope not to freeze you in inaction, but to inspire you to understand the urgent need for your participation in solutions. Thank you for staying present with us in this moment. Thank you for all that you are doing – and will do – to turn the tide and help create a healthy future where all beings can not only stay alive... but thrive.




